Metropolitan Archbishop Stefan Soroka will celebrate Holy Thursday, services (Vespers with Hierarchical Divine Liturgy of St. Basil the Great and the Consecration of Chrism and the Sacramental Washing of the Feet) beginning at 10:00AM on April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010 at Assumption Catholic Church in Perth Amboy. These solemn services commemorate the events of Holy Thursday when Our Lord shared the Mystical Supper in the upper room, the institution of the Holy Eucharist, and then he lovingly washed the feet of his apostles, the commissioning of his apostles and those who would come later, to a ministry of service, to and for others. Archbishop Stefan will wash the feet of 12 of his priests, in imitation of Christ, signifying that he who will preach the bread of the Word of God and will break the bread of the Lord's Supper must kneel before others, in total humility and service and wash their feet, first, before any of his ministries will bear fruit. The Chrism (Myron) which will be consecrated is made from olive oil and many kinds of herbal essences and is distributed to all of the parish churches for use during the year. This is a once in a lifetime chance to witness and pray at this sacred service that is usually only celebrated in our Cathedral in
